Unless otherwise noted, we encourage children to have a “supply kit” that can go back and forth to school. We encourage all supplies to be labeled.

## **Kindergarten**

- School Supplies to keep at home:
  - One box of Sharpened #2 Yellow Pencils
  - One boxes of 24 Crayons
  - 1 pair of child scissors
  - Pack of Glue Sticks (small glue sticks)
  
- School Supplies that will come back and forth between home:
  - Headphones (do not have to be expensive) placed in a large Zip-loc bag labeled with your child's name. **\*\*\*NO EARBUDS\*\*** Please send your child with headphones on the day that they report to school. They will be sent back home with them to use at home as well.
  - A spill proof water bottle with a sports cap or pop up straw labeled with your child's name.
  - A change of clothes appropriate for the current season, which should include a pair of socks and underwear. Please put in a Zip-loc bag labeled with your child's name (this will stay in your child's backpack).
  - We will provide your child with their own pencil box and supplies that will stay at school...
  
- Optional:
  - 1 Box of Kleenex

## **1st Grade**

Here is the list of supplies that will be helpful for our school year! We will be providing 2 pencil boxes for your child. (One we will keep at school and one we will fill with the supplies and send home), so no pencil box or pouch is needed. Please do not send in folders, pencil sharpeners, or any additional supplies not listed. Thank you!

- 2 boxes (24 pack) of Crayola Crayons
- 2 black dry erase markers (Expo if possible)
- 4-6 glue sticks
- Box of Freezer Ziploc bags (gallon size)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 12 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga)
- Plastic water bottle with a sipper lid (must have lid)
- 2 pair Fiskars kid scissors – 1 for school, **1 pair keep at home**
- 1 wide ruled notebook – **keep at home** for writing
- 1 pack Crayola Markers (thin line)-**keep at home**
- 1 pair of headphones (No earbuds please) - for personal use only – **Might want to buy a pair for home,**

## **2nd Grade**

- Headphones
- 2 highlighters- 2 different colors
- Box of crayons- 24
- Colored pencils
- Fiskars scissors
- Sharpened #2 pencils
- Pink eraser
- 5 glue sticks
- Pencil box
- 3 black & white composition books- 100 pages
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- Girls- Box of gallon size baggies
- Boys-Box of snack size baggies

## **3rd Grade**

- Headphones for iPad
- #2 Pencils (replenish during the year)
- 1 pair of scissors (bigger scissors are acceptable)
- Box of crayons (24 count is a good number)
- Glue sticks – no bottled glue please
- 2-3 different colored highlighters
- Zippered Pencil bag (No pencil boxes)
- Pencil Sharpener with lid
- 1 Wide ruled Notebook

## **4th Grade**

- Pouch/Container to store supplies and bring into school.
- 12 Pencils- Pencils that are pre-sharpened work best.
- erasers
- Crayons –no bigger than a 24 pack
- 2 highlighters
- Scissors
- 2 boxes of tissues for the classroom
- Earbuds or Headphones- small, easy to carry, and inexpensive. They break or are easily lost. Please mark them with a personalized label.
- 2 Dry Erase Markers
- Optional:
  - Personal sharpeners
  - Colored pencils
  - Water bottles
- Please label each item your child's name.

## **5th Grade**

- OPTION 1:
  - 1 five-subject notebook (may need another one later in the year)
  - Different solid colored folders (red, blue and green)
- OR OPTION 2:
  - One Large Binder and we will provide you with three notebooks and three folders to put inside
- OTHER SUGGESTED SUPPLIES FOR EVERYDAY USE:
  - Pencils (Non-mechanical)
  - Erasers
  - Ruler (Cm & Inch), Protractor
  - Scissors
  - Glue sticks
  - Highlighters
  - Wide-Ruled Lined Paper (this will stay in the classroom)
  - Coloring Supplies (Markers/Crayons/Colored Pencils)
  - Headphones/earbuds
  - Water Bottle labeled with Student Name
  - Tissue box(es)
  - Pencil bag or box for storing all supplies above that will travel from home to school for students that are coming in once a week.
  - NO STAPLERS/PENS/WHITE OUT

## **6th Grade**

- 1 ruler (inches/centimeters)
- 1 protractor
- 1 pack of crayons (max. of 24)
- 1 pack of sharpened pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener with cover
- 4 highlighters (any color)
- 1 pack of 10 markers
- 2 Expo dry erase markers (fine point)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 single subject spiral notebooks (1 of each color: yellow, purple)
- 5 two-pocket folders (1 of each color: red, blue, yellow, green, purple)
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones
- 1 pencil bag
