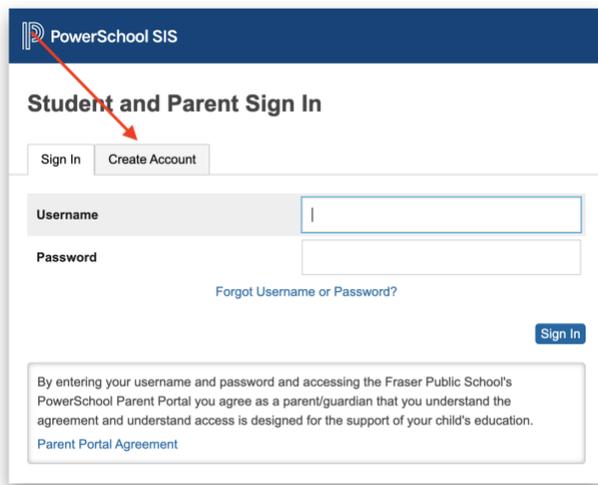


Instructions for creating a PowerSchool Parent Portal account and associating your student(s):

- 1.) First, have at hand the Access ID and Access Password for your student(s). You will have either received these in an email from your student's school or you can call the office of your student's school to obtain them.

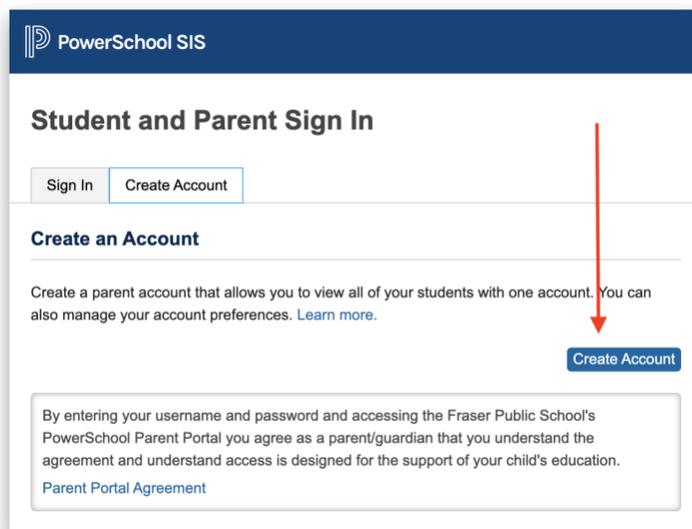
NOTE: Please use Google Chrome to create this account and future access to PowerSchool

- 3.) Click **Create Account**



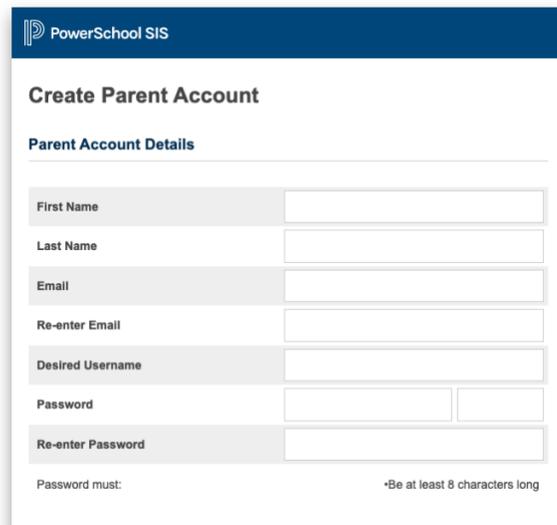

- 4.) Click **Create Account**



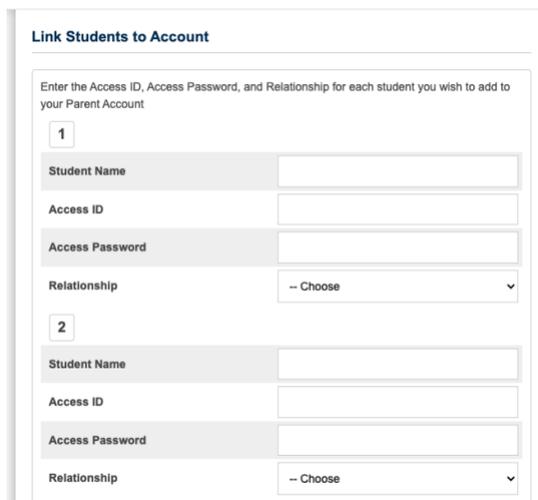

- 5.) In the **Parent Account Details** section, enter your first name, last name, email address, desired username (email address is best) and create a password that is a minimum of 8 characters, with at least one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter, and one number.
