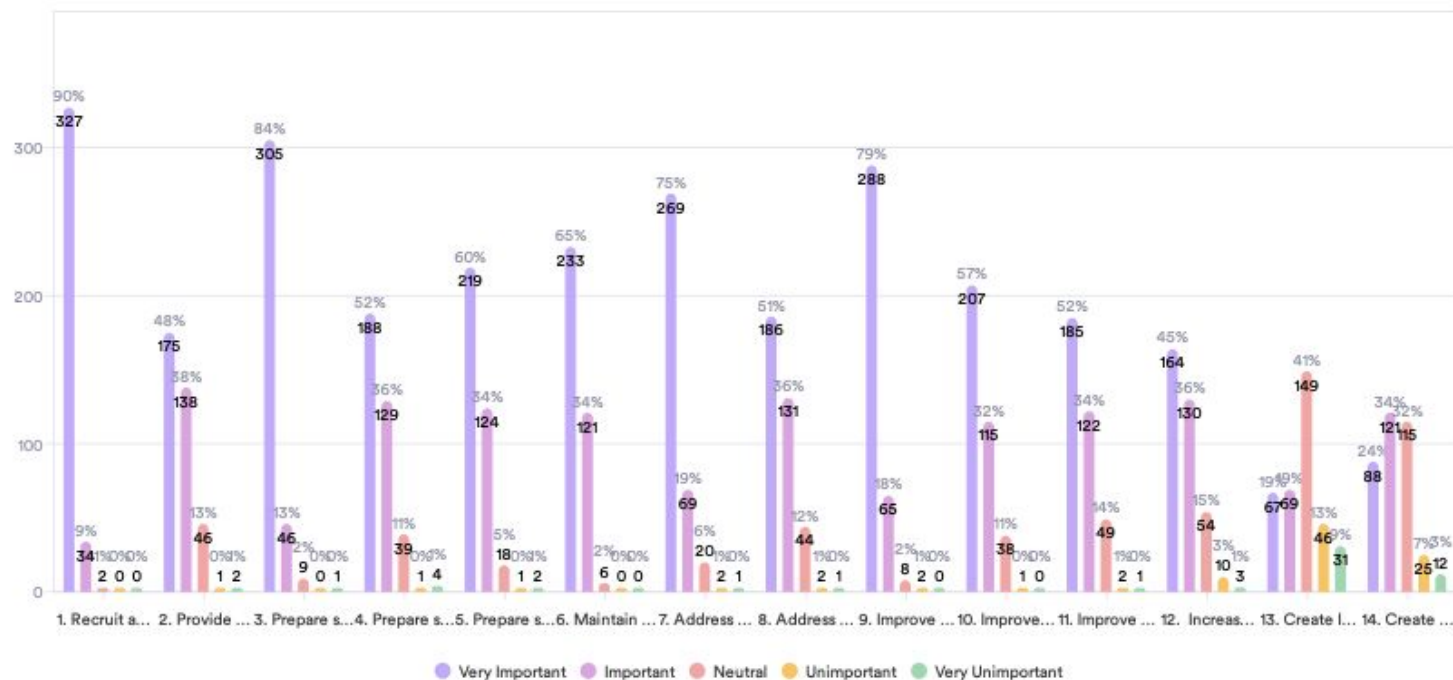

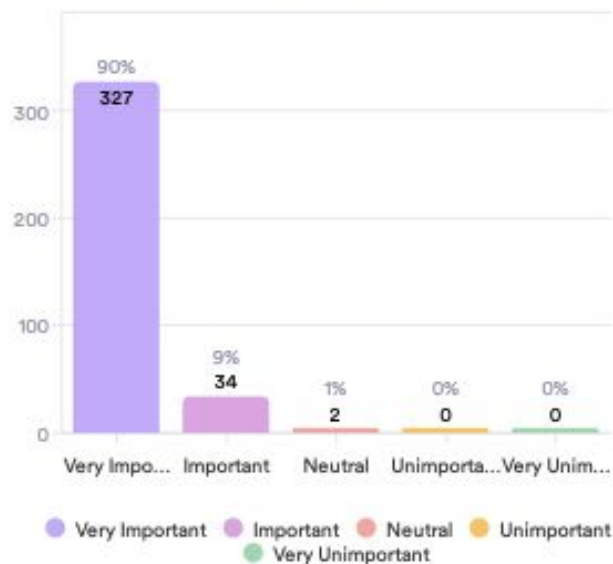

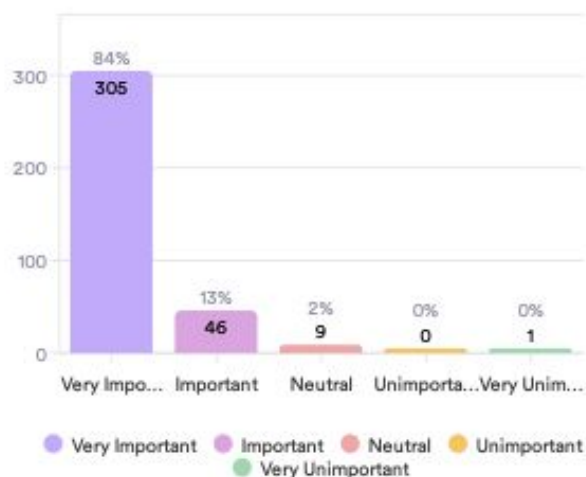

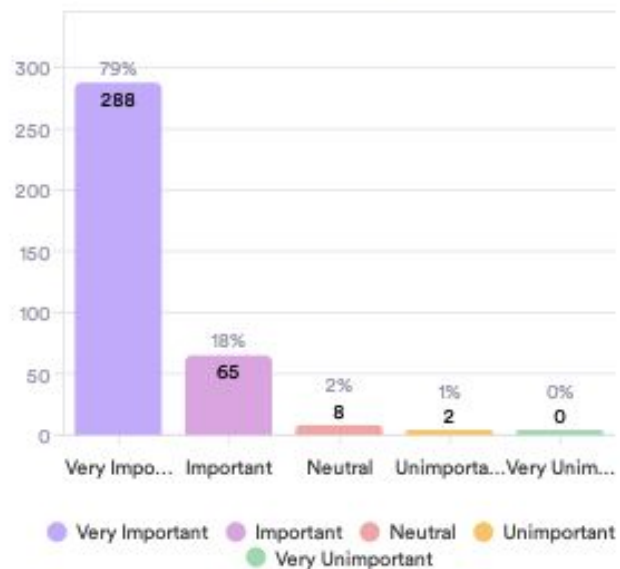

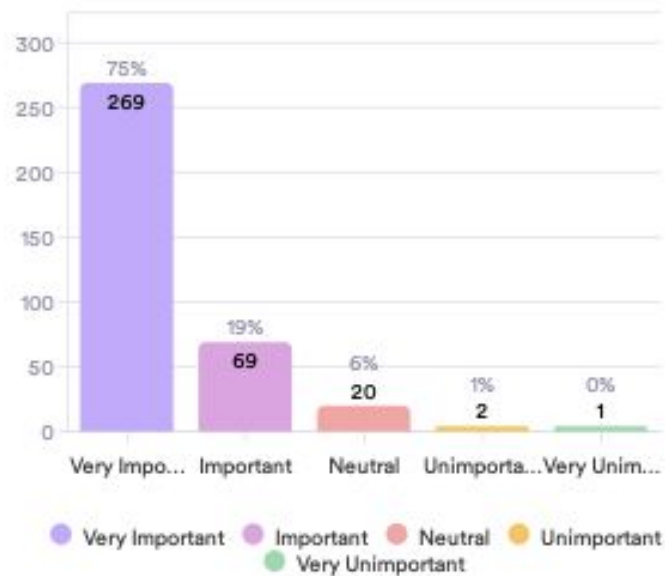

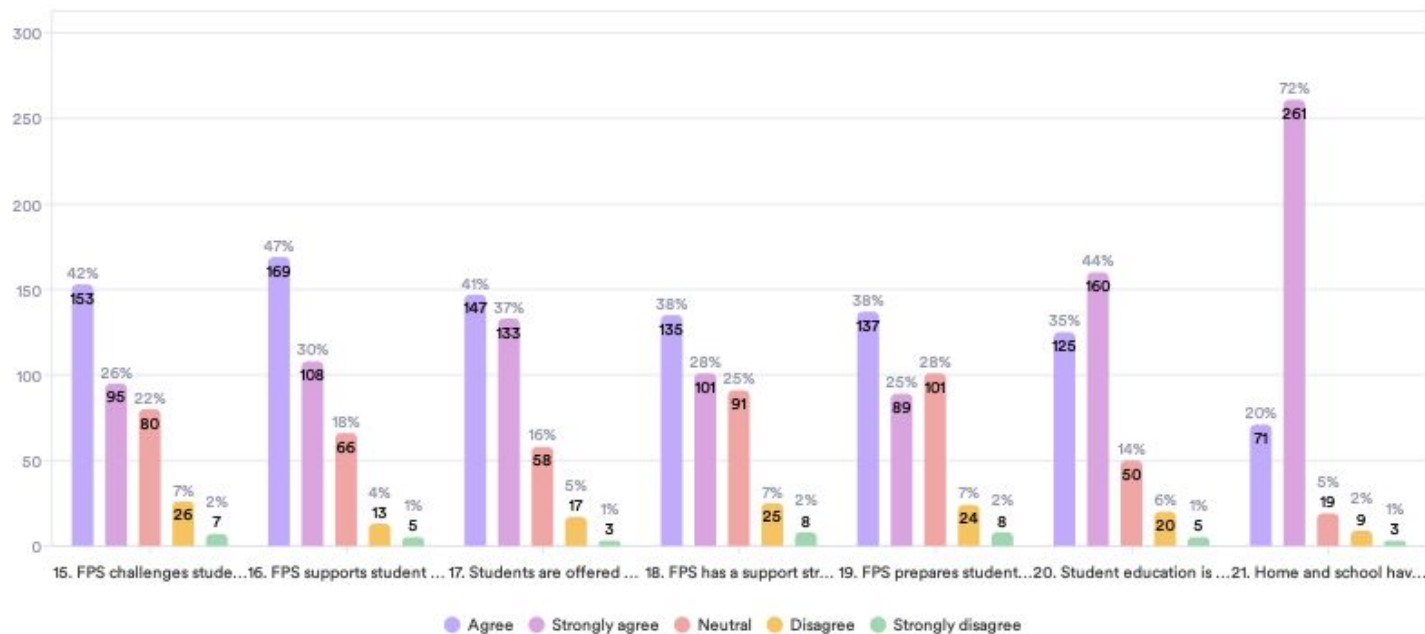

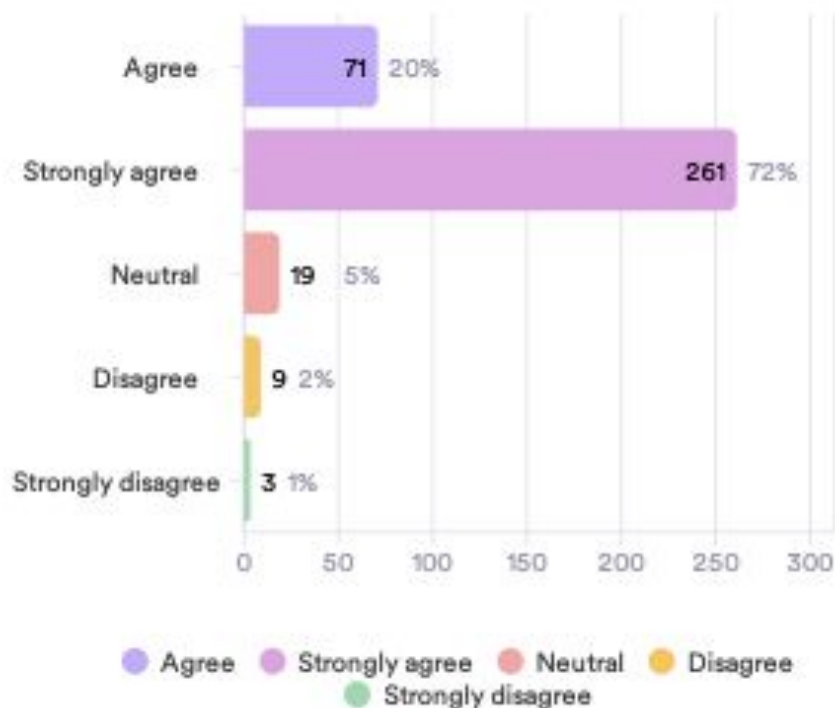

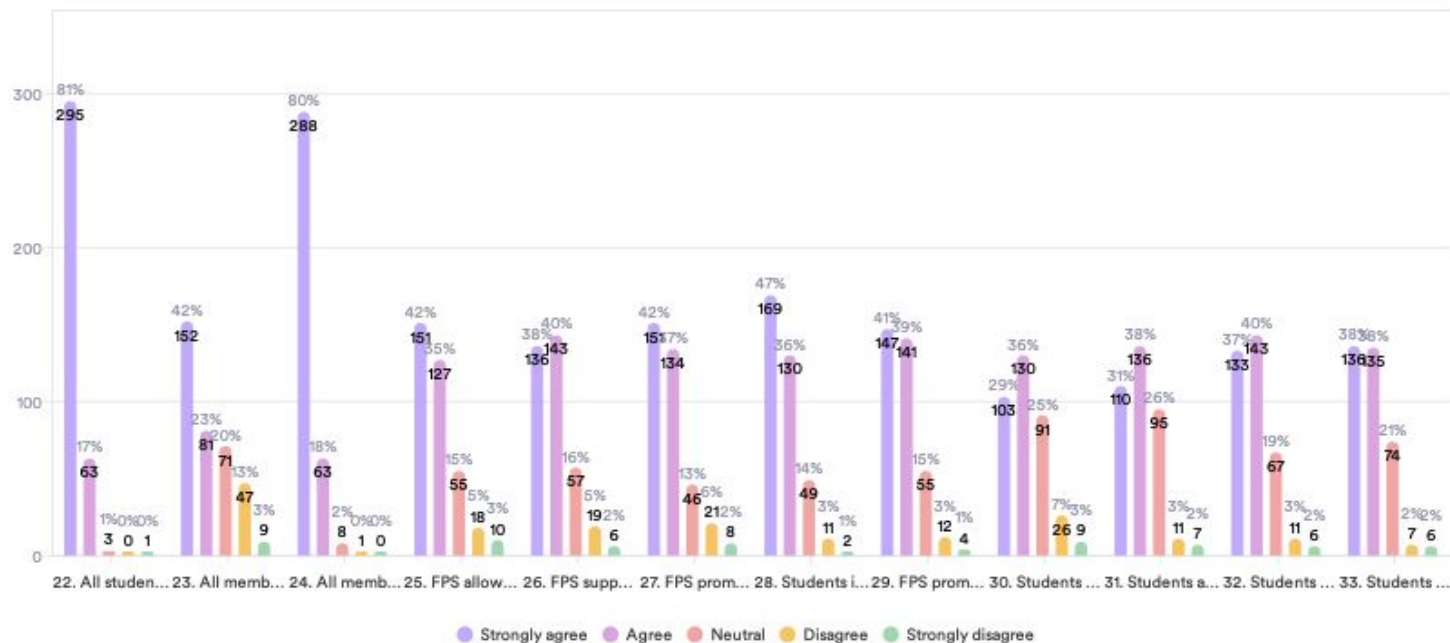
21. Home and school have a shared responsibility for a student's growth and academic success.

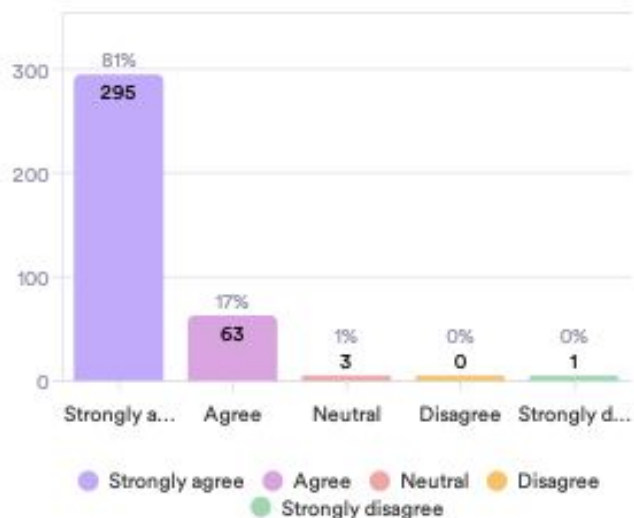
Educating the "Whole Child": Please indicate your level of agreement with the following statements in Fraser Public Schools (FPS).

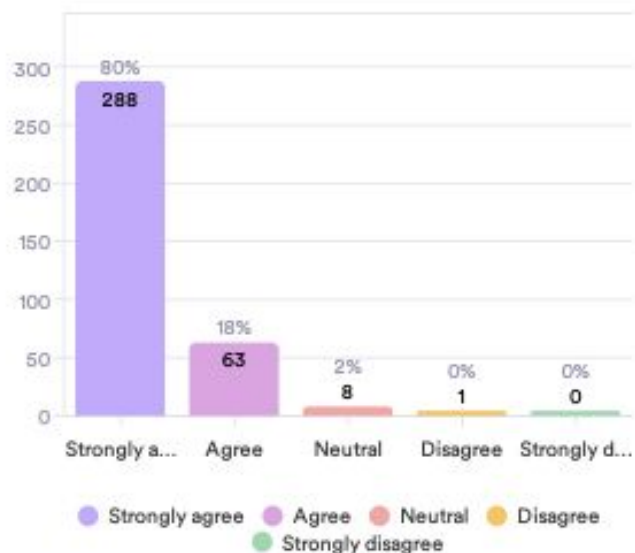

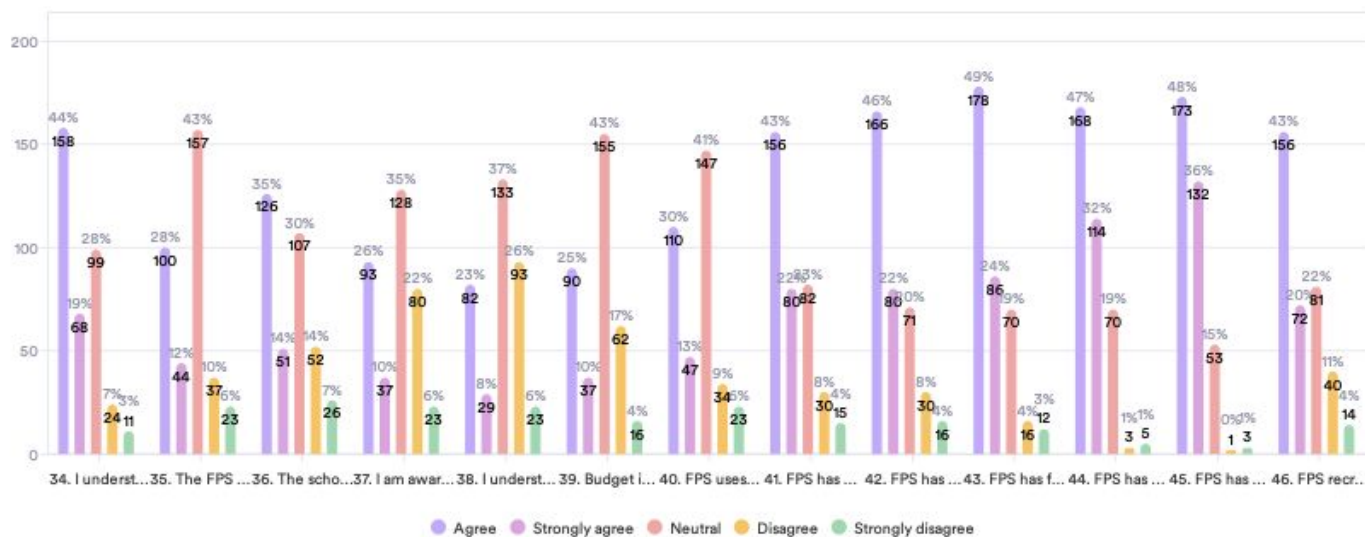

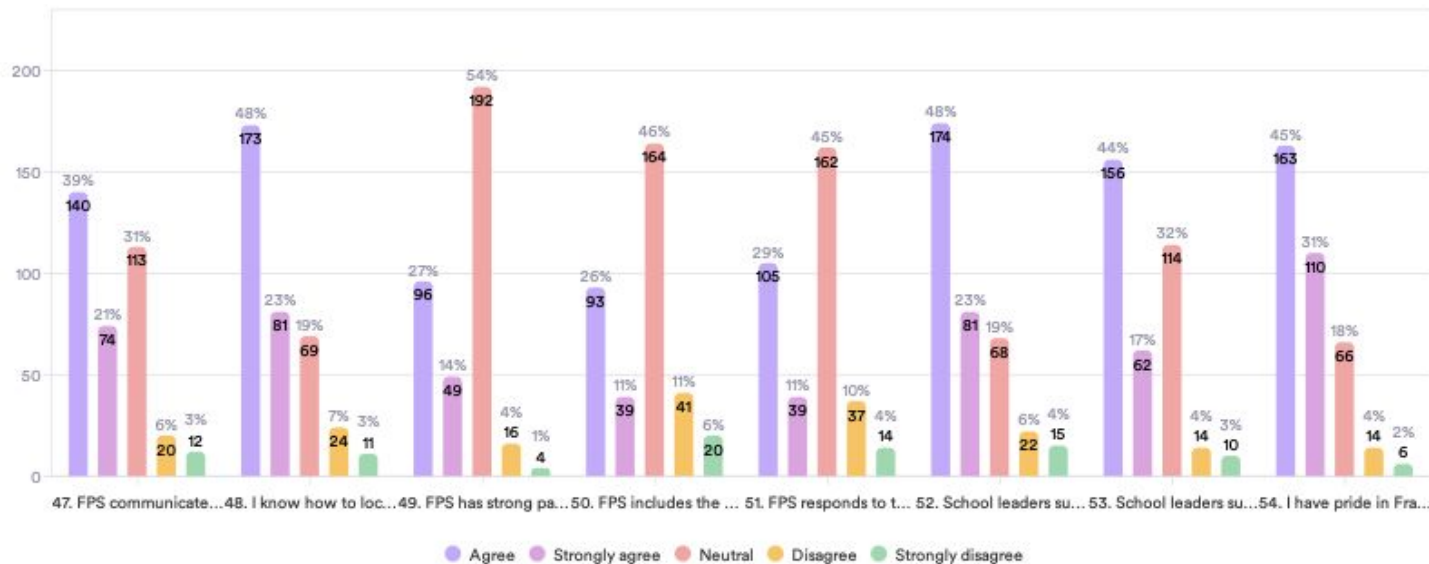

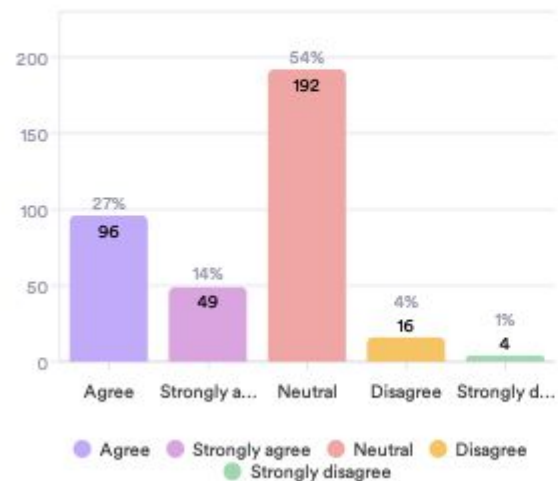

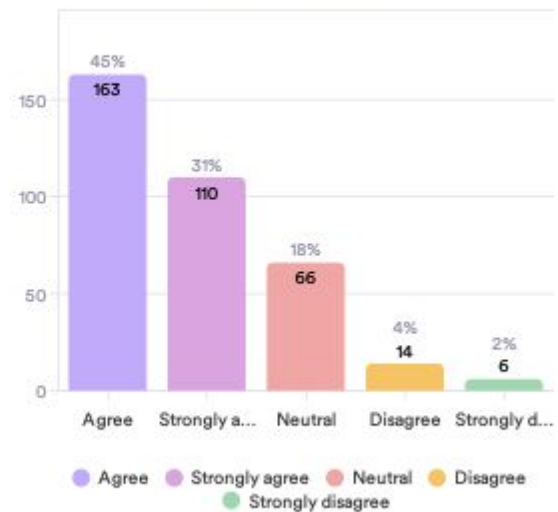

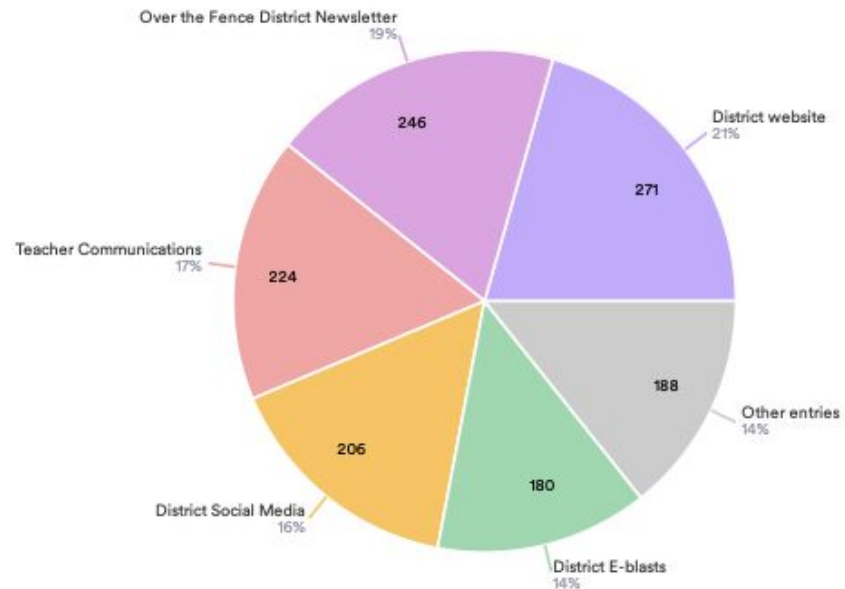
54. I have pride in Fraser Public Schools.

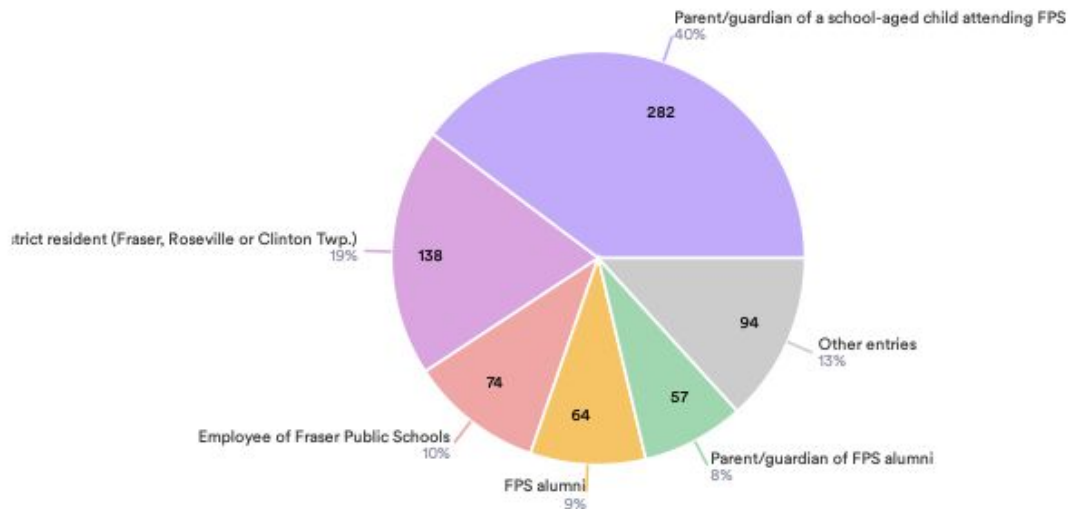
55. How do you get your information about Fraser Public Schools (check all that apply):

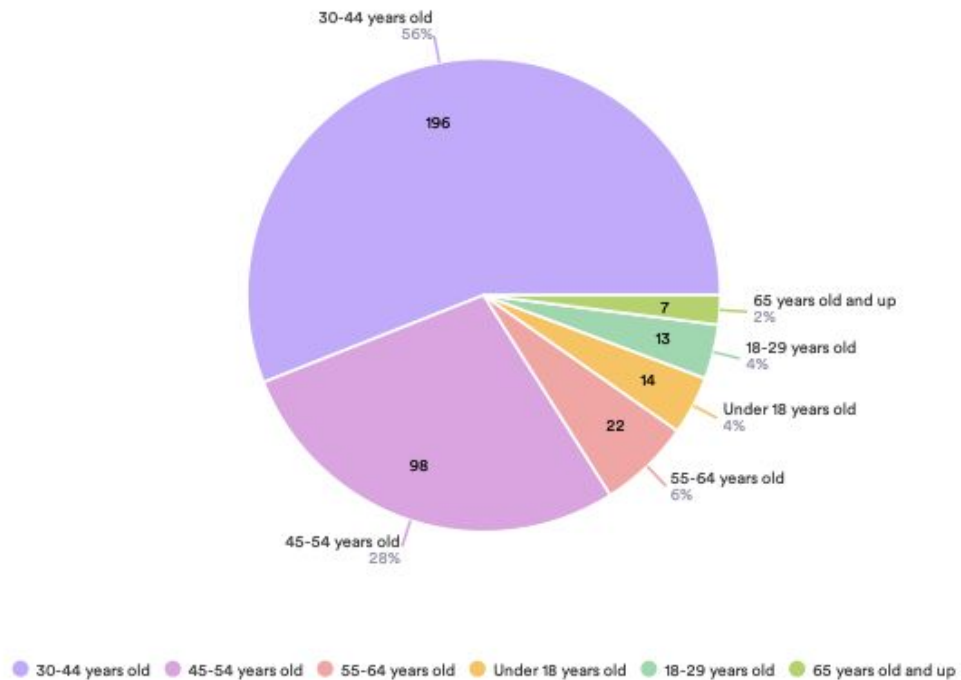
59. Which of the following categories best describe your role or roles in relation to the Fraser School District (FPS)?
