

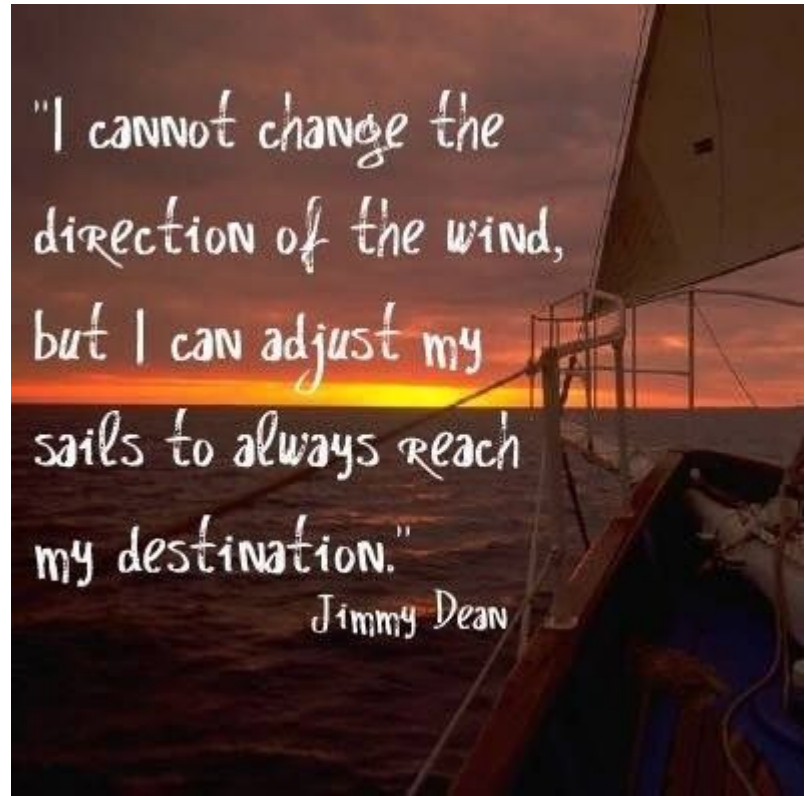

Governance - Keys

Establish renewal committee responsible for creating guidance for districts and schools, focused on unfinished learning and health and wellness (mental and physical). The Committee should be reflective of the geographic, cultural, racial and socioeconomic diversity of the state.

- The Committee should include parent representatives.
- The Committee should include teacher representatives.
- The Committee should include student representatives.
- The Committee should include representatives of out-of-school providers and community-based organizations

All of the Chairs will be on this Committee as Co-chairs and Carrie Wozniak will be the Chair.

Communications - Keys

Designate a staff member who will have single-point accountability over external recovery and renewal communications.

- Trauma-Informed Practices

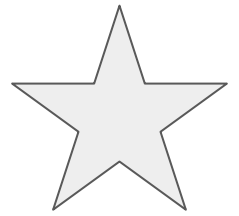
Physical Health - Keys
