

What to Send With Your Child

- A complete change of clothing (pants, shirt, socks, underwear) to be left at school. Please place items in a Ziploc bag and label with your child's name.
- Rest time items child desires (small pillow/blanket/crib sheet/stuffed animal) in a labeled drawstring bag (garbage bag/laundry bag) that is able to hang on a hook. Please label everything with your child's name!
- A roomy schoolbag/backpack that she/he can open easily, labeled with your child's name. We have found that many children have difficulty manipulating the toggle closures on some schoolbags. Please **do not send backpacks on wheels**, as we have no place to store these. Please be sure that the backpack is large enough to hold a standard pocket folder and lunch box.
- A healthy snack and water. You'll need to provide a snack every day. We do not allow children to share snacks because of food allergies and family preferences about what their children eat. Please put your child's snack in a separate bag from his/her lunch. Please label "Snack" along with his/her name (some children don't know what is lunch and what is snack if they are both in the lunchbox). Both disposable and reusable water bottles may be used. No open cups, sippy cups, or large thermoses will be permitted in the classroom.
- Lunch. If you are sending a cold lunch, please label the lunchbox or bag with your child's name, as we always end up with several identical lunch boxes. If ordering hot lunch, you should receive information or visit the Fraser Food Service site by [clicking here](#).

Please have your child wear his/her D.K. nametag received at the Meet & Greet on the first day of school. Please mark one of the following on the nametag to indicate how your child will be going home:

Car (if child will be picked up and driven home)

Bus # ____ (please note the bus number on the tag)

Dooley (if child will be attending after school care at Dooley)

OTHER (please discuss arrangements with your child's teacher)

On the first day of school your child will bring home a blue home/school folder. This folder is an important means of communication. It is to travel back and forth each day. Class newsletters and school notices will be sent home in it and you can use it to send information to your child's teacher or the office.
