PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY

The Fraser Public Schools District recognizes that a student's education is a responsibility shared by the school and the family. To support the goal of the school district to improve student achievement, the schools and parents/families must work as knowledgeable partners throughout the student's education.

The district in collaboration with parents and families shall establish practices that enhance parent/family involvement and reflect the specific needs of students and their families. To this end, as part of each building's School Improvement Plan, the district shall encourage each school to develop a parental involvement component, developed with and approved by parents. The parental involvement component shall include opportunities for increasing parent/family involvement in addition to, but not limited to, the following:

- Communication between home and school is regular, two-way, and meaningful.
- Family learning is promoted and supported.
- Parents / families play an integral role in assisting student learning.
- Parents / families are welcome in the school, and their support and assistance are sought.
- Community resources are made available to strengthen school, family, and student learning.

The district supports professional development opportunities for staff members to enhance understanding of effective parent / family involvement strategies. The district also recognizes the importance of administrative leadership in setting expectations and creating a climate conducive to parent / family participation.
