EVALUATIONS

Fraser Public Schools is committed to providing students with disabilities a free and appropriate public education consistent with federal and state laws. Fraser Public Schools provides evaluations for students who are suspected of having a disability under IDEA (the federal special education law) and/or Section 504. If there is reason to suspect that the student has a disability, staff may use the Student Support Team process to recommend an evaluation. Parental consent will be requested prior to evaluation. Following the 504 or special education evaluation, a team meeting is held to review the evaluation data and develop an appropriate program for the student.
