## **Prom Ticket Purchase Procedures:**

1. **On March 5**th & 6th, Prom Ticket Purchase Forms and Guest forms will be distributed in students' English classes. (These documents may also be picked up from Ms. Zary in room 1708 or Ms. Perkins in room 1307.)

- 2. **From March 5<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>** students should complete any necessary guest forms for non-FHS students. All guest forms must be submitted by the end of the day on March 22<sup>nd</sup>. However, tickets for guests cannot be purchased until these forms are completed, so it is in your best interest to complete them as soon as possible.
- 3. **From March 5th-17th** coordinate with your friends to determine table groups. Tables at the Mirage seat 10 people. When you know who you would like to sit with, fill out **this google form**. (If you do not have a full group of ten, you will be combined with other groups at the discretion of the class sponsors.)
- 4. **During the Week of March 11**<sup>th</sup>-**15**<sup>th</sup>, visit Mrs. Loush in the Main Office and Mrs. Cook/Mrs. Romanski in the Media Center to check your fines and to pay any outstanding fines. You will receive a stamp from each of these stations on your blue Prom Ticket Purchase Form. (*Tickets may not be purchased until you have both of these stamps!*)

5. Decide on the Day/Time that your group plans to purchase their tickets (*see below*). Please do your best to have all group members attend the same ticket-purchasing session. When you come to purchase your tickets, you must bring your blue Prom Ticket Purchase Form with items #1 & #2 complete.

No tickets will be sold at the door.
