Dear Parent/Guardian:

On Graduation Day, June 8, 2024, the senior parents are sponsoring a Senior All Night Graduation Party. This party offers the graduating Class of 2024 an opportunity to be together one last time to celebrate in an alcohol and drug free environment. This year we will be at an offsite venue called Legacy 925. Activities include K1 speed go-karts, trampolines, arcade games, laser tag, bowling, and much more. Food and drinks will be provided throughout the evening. The ticket price is \$55.00 from 2/26/24 – 3/22/24 and will increase after spring break, to \$65.00 from 4/2/24 – 5/24/24. Your permission is needed for your graduate to attend the party (see form attached). Your son or daughter must have this signed permission slip with them when they purchase their ticket at school. Also, you must go online and fill out the attached 3 waivers in order for your student to participate in the activities.

All Night Party Rules

- 1. Tickets <u>must</u> be purchased in advance and will be sold starting 2/26/24. Students may purchase tickets before and after school in Mrs. Holmes office. Tickets cannot be purchased without a signed permission slip. **Make checks** payable to Fraser High School.
- 2. The party is limited to the graduates of Class of 2024. Admission to the party is by ticket only. **There will be no tickets sold at the door.** Each student's name and ticket number will be recorded on a master list and checked off at Fraser High School before heading to the facility. Tickets are non-transferable.
- 3. Students will be checked in at Fraser beginning at 9:00 pm. All students must arrive to school no later than 9:30 pm. If your child has not checked in by then, you will be called. All students will be released around 4:30 am. Once checked in, students will not be allowed to leave until the 4:30 a.m. dismissal.
- 4. Entry to check in process will be through the cafeteria doors on the Klein side of FHS.
- 5. Upon entering the building, all individuals will be checked for inappropriate items such as alcohol, vaping devices, and tobacco products. The student can bring no drinks or food of any kind into the building.
- 6. Students suspected of being in possession or under the influence of illegal substances or alcohol will be removed from the party without a refund. Parents will be called to pick up any offenders. The Fraser Police may be contacted if their assistance is needed.
- 7. Once all students are checked in, they will load the district buses and leave school by 9:45 pm. Transportation costs are provided by Fraser High School. All students are required to take the bus to and from the venue. Students will be at the venue from 10:30 pm to 3:45 am. The busses will depart the venue at 3:45 am and will return to Fraser High School (Klein Rd side) around 4:30 am.
- 8. Students will not be permitted to drive to the venue, nor will they be allowed to leave there unless they are picked up by a parent.
- 9. No purses or bags of any kind will be allowed at the venue. There will not be anywhere for the students to leave their possessions, so we encourage them to leave all their valuables at home.
- 10. The attached 3 waivers, must be filled out in order for your student to participate in the activities.
